MSFT6002 *Cultural Consideration and Application of Family Therapy with Asian Chinese Families*
(1 module)

This course aims to provide students with a theoretical foundation and understanding in perceptual, conceptual, and intervention skills of traditional and current family therapy approaches, with an emphasis on intergenerational, psychodynamic, and experiential approaches. Cultural consideration is integrated into each clinical approach. Within cultural contexts the course closely examines the influence of important emotional experiences on individuals and various relationship dynamics and explores clinical interventions in individual therapy, couple therapy, family therapy, play therapy, and treatment of trauma. Their implications for Asian Chinese families will be explored and discussed.
